BILLIARD TABLE MAINTENANCE AND WARRANTY

1. Only use brushes on cloth. (vacuum will stretch cloth and wear out nap on cloth)
2. Use regular furniture polish on wood. Put polish on cloth then apply to wood finish.
3. To help the pockets break in, use a leather conditioner on the pockets for first month every week then once every 6 months. Saddle soap or a baseball glove conditioner works great!
4. Keep table covered when not being used.
5. Do not store any items on top of table. (this will leave rings, lines or impressions in the cloth)
6. If something is spilled on cloth, blot it up with a dry rag as soon as possible.

Teflon spray is a new product that is maintained differently than above. The manufacture recommends using a vacuum (with a brush) instead of brushing. Teflon is a treatment, it does wear off and is recommended to be reapplied ever year.

During the first month of play on your billiard table you may notice the following things. Initially you may notice lines in the felt. These lines are fold marks from when the cloth was in the package. After playing and brushing the table a few times you will notice these lines will begin to fade. You may also notice that the balls don't seem to roll straight. This is caused by the fact that the table is Settling. The table will settle evenly but may not settle evenly at the same rate. If you are still noticing a problem after three weeks please give us a call and we will be happy to send a service technician to fix the problem.

With your billiard table there are periodic things you will need to check. These are:

1. Is the table level? (This can be done with a two foot level) Table can be level by placing shims under the legs.
2. Check to see if rails are tight. Overtime rail bolts may vibrate loose. These can be tightened with a socket wrench.
3. If your table has plastic pockets, you may need to keep a check on the hardware that was sent with your table to make sure they are not pulling out. These can be replaced in the corners of pockets by small screws.

ALL TABLES INSTALLED BY BACKYARDS AND BASEMENTS HAVE A 90-DAY WORKMANSHIP WARRANTY FROM THE DATE OF THE INSTALL. ANY SERVICE CALLS AFTER THIRTY (90) DAYS WILL HAVE A \$105.00 TRIP CHARGE (plus mileage if more than 20 miles- no exceptions).

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
